- Researched and written by the Indiana University Lilly Family School of Philanthropy










#### 2021 contributions: \$484.85 billion by source of contributions






#### 2021 contributions: \$484.85 billion by type of recipient organization\*



## Changes in giving by source: 2019–2020 and 2020–2021, 2019–2021 cumulative








#### Total giving, 1981-2021






#### Giving by foundations, 1981-2021 (in billions of dollars)










#### Total giving by source in five-year spans, 1982-2021





## Total charitable giving graphed with the Standard & Poor's 500 Index, 1981-2021





## Individual giving as a percentage of disposable personal income, 1981-2021 (in current dollars)





















(in billions of inflation-adjusted dollars, 2021 = \$100, does not include "unallocated" and "giving to individuals")










## Million Gifts + Since 2008



Bill and Melinda Gates Account for \$15 Billion in 2021 Mackenzie Scott accounts for \$133.5 Million in 2021






